Peace Officers Memorial Day and Police Week is an observance in the United States that pays tribute to the local, state, and federal peace officers who have died, or who have been disabled, in the line of duty. It is celebrated May 15th of each year.

International Firefighters' Day is celebrated on May 4th because that is Saint Florian's day, and Saint Florian, who was said to be one of the first commanding firefighters of an actual Roman battalion and saved many lives, is the patron saint of firefighters.

While the meeting schedule missed this mark for May 4th, we still recognize Firefighters and meet the deadline for National Police Week. The idea of this resolution is that we place this on the calendar every year and then (when we have no social distancing requirements) we do something each year to celebrate the accomplishments of our Police and Firefighters.
