HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS & ELECTRONIC WASTE

Household hazardous waste and electronic waste can be dropped off free of charge to residents* Monday through Saturday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The Salt Lake County Health Department operates two Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) collection facilities.

The HHW facilities will accept residential products such as paint, pesticides, oil, transmission fluid, antifreeze, batteries, and other household chemicals.

HOUSEHOLD WASTE

Black household containers are collected once weekly year-round.

CONTAINER PLACEMENT

- » Curbside by 6:30 a.m. on collection day
- » Wheels against curb or 2 ft. from the blacktop
- » Away from overhead obstacles such as trees
- » 4 feet apart from other containers
- » Away from mailboxes, parked vehicles, and fences

HOLIDAY COLLECTION

- » Containers are collected on all holidays except:
Independence Day Thanksgiving
Christmas New Year's Day
- » Should a holiday fall on a scheduled collection day, all collections will be delayed one day for the remainder of the week, to include a Saturday collection. The normal collection schedule will resume the following week.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- » Dirt, rocks, sod or concrete
- » Flammable material, gas, paint, coal, or hot ashes
- » Hazardous or toxic waste
- » Explosive or radioactive materials
- » Automotive materials – motor oil, tires or batteries
- » Construction debris – remodeling/demolition debris
- » More than 5 gallons of acceptable liquid



RECYCLING

Blue recycle containers are collected once weekly year-round.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Dirty Paper Plates & Cups
Paint Cans
Printer & Toner Cartridges
Styrofoam Packaging
Wood Scraps
Shredded paper**

Cardboard (flatten or cut)
Cereal & Food Boxes/Cartons (remove plastic liner)

CURBSIDE GREEN WASTE

Green yard waste containers are collected once weekly on a seasonal basis.

Program begins on the first Monday collection in April and ends with the last Friday collection in November.

KEEP IT GREEN

- » Place only loose grass clippings, leaves, non-treated wood, small tree branches, and dirt-free vegetative matter in container.
- » **DO NOT bag any items please!**

KEEP IT CLEAN

- » Please DO NOT place these items in container:
Dirt/Rocks Sod Cardboard
Manure Concrete Plastic Bags
- » All materials should fall freely from the cart when dumped – please do not overload.
- » Lid of the cart must close completely – branches should not stick out of the container.
- » Place cart curbside by 6:30 a.m. on your scheduled collection day during seasonal periods April through November.



FREE DOCUMENT SHREDDING & E-WASTE RECYCLING

The city holds **free shredding and electronic waste recycling days** quarterly for residents. The shred days are held in the City Hall parking lot, 8000 S. Redwood Road and are typically scheduled the first Saturday of the following months:

February May August November

- » A written agreement for use must be reviewed, signed by the property owner and confirmed by a Public Works representative in order to complete a reservation.
- » Dumpsters are free of charge to West Jordan residents but may only be scheduled once every 60 days per residence, subject to availability.
- » Dumpsters are for residential refuse only and may not be used by businesses or commercial contractors.
