Dear West Jordan Political Candidates:

The annual West Jordan Western Stampede Independence Day Celebration is coming up July 4, 5 and 6 in Veterans Memorial Park. A West Jordan candidate for office has applied for vendor booth space in the park for campaign purposes. To ensure equal opportunity, the events department is making park space available for a fee to non-commercial interests, including political candidates, for the full duration of the city celebration. Non-commercial plots will be available for purchase beginning June 20 at 9 a.m. Specific plot selection will be on a first-come, first-served basis and will be open to non-commercial interests, including political candidates.

The non-commercial plots are marked on a map that can be found at westernstampede.com. There will be two rows of plots on each on the south side of Veterans Park at the entrance (one of two) just across from the Viridian Event Center. Each plot is 10'x10', costs \$50 (for all three days) and does not include any equipment. You will need to provide any canopies, tables, chairs, etc. you wish to use. To select and purchase a plot, please go to westernstampede.com and click on "tickets". Select "Non-commercial Space" as the event and follow selection and purchase instructions from there. Again, this will be available June 20 at 9 a.m.

Our vendor policy includes a non-compete clause – we do not allow more than one vendor to sell a particular type of food or more than two vendors to sell the same type of non-food products. The non-compete clause applies to the reserved non-commercial spaces in that we ask you not to sell or give away the same products that are sold by one of the vendors. You should have received a list of those products and food items via email. Please do not plan to sell or give away any of the items listed.
